

Known Sources for Handling,  
Decontamination and Disposing  
of Radioactive Materials



Gentlemen:

As a result of our expanding Naval Nuclear Fleet capability, the frequency in which Naval Nuclear components are exposed to actual service conditions aboard ships of the fleet is on the increase. Therefore, previously isolated instances wherein radioactive equipment removed from service for purposes of inspection, test and evaluation are also increasing. Thereby, the problem of determining known, licensed and proven firms capable of handling, decontaminating and disposing of residual radioactive material is identified.

Currently, facilities and personnel available to us in performance of these tasks is quite limited. We would then inquire of you whether the AEC could provide us with any listing of firms which may have been compiled for your own like purposes, if available.

Any information which you may provide would prevent needless duplication of effort with corresponding benefits derived by the Government and the general public at large.

Your prompt response will be appreciated.
