SUBJECT: IMPLEMENTATION SCHEDULES FOR 10 CFR 50 APPENDIX R, SECTION III.G,
MODIFICATIONS AT TURKEY POINT PLANT UNITS 3 AND 4

By letter dated May 18, 1984, you have provided the proposed schedules for completion of the required modifications and submittal of the necessary technical specifications for the alternate shutdown capability approved in our Safety Evaluation dated April 16, 1984. The modifications for Unit 3 will be completed by startup from the currently scheduled refueling outage in the Spring of 1985. The modifications for Unit 4 will be completed by the start up from the currently scheduled refueling outage in the Fall of 1985 and the necessary Technical Specifications will be submitted for the NRC staff review.

The proposed schedules are in accordance with 10 CFR 50.48(c)(4) and no schedular exemptions are required.

By letter dated May 31, 1984, you have provided the proposed schedules for completion of the required modifications, both outage and non-outage related, for Appendix R, Section III.G, modifications except for alternate shutdown which is discussed above. The schedules provided relate to the Exemptions granted and our attached Safety Evaluation dated March 27, 1984, and received by Florida Power and Light Company in April. You have indicated non-outage related modifications for Units 3 and 4 will be completed by January 1985, and the outage related by the next refueling outages described above.

The proposed schedules are in accordance with 10 CFR 50.48(c)(2) and (c)(3) and no schedular exemptions are required. If significant changes are required due to procurement of equipment or other problems, you have indicated that we would be notified in a timely fashion and any required schedular exemptions, with supporting justification, requested at that time.
