SUBJECT: EXEMPTION RELATING TO THE ANNUAL EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS EXERCISE FOR TURKEY POINT PLANT, UNIT NOS. 3 AND 4

The Commission has issued the enclosed exemption from the requirements of 10 CFR Part 50, Appendix E, Section IV.F, concerning provisions for the frequency of scheduling of emergency preparedness exercises. The exemption provides that the Florida Power and Light Company may schedule the 1984 emergency preparedness exercise for Turkey Point Plant, Units 3 and 4, on November 7, 1984, and all subsequent exercises to be scheduled for November.

A copy of the exemption is being forwarded to the Office of the Federal Register for publication. A copy of the Notice of Environmental Assessment and Findings of No Significant Impact was published in the Federal Register on September 27, 1984 (49 FR 38211).
