

SUBJECT: Modification of Commission Order Dated February 23, 1984

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's Order of February 23, 1984, directed you to implement your upgraded emergency operating procedures by December 31, 1985, for the Turkey Point Plant Units 3 and 4. Section IV of the Order allows for extensions of time for completing items detailed in the Order for good cause shown.

By letter dated December 23, 1985, you requested that the dates in the Order of February 23, 1984, relating to the implementation of the upgraded emergency operating procedures be extended from December 31, 1985, to March 31, 1986. You have indicated that the upgraded emergency operating procedures have been recently used in operator requalification training at the Westinghouse simulator. However, because of recent problems identified in various areas such as the Auxiliary Feedwater System, you have requested that your staff perform an engineering review of the upgraded emergency operating procedures in relation to the existing Turkey Point Plant design basis prior to their implementation.

Based on telephone conversations with members of your staff, it is our understanding that the extension request allows for completion of the review, resolution of findings, necessary Plant Nuclear Safety Committee reviews, issuance of the revised procedures, and allowance for any unanticipated contingencies which may occur. It is also our understanding that the updated emergency operating procedures will be implemented prior to the requested date if possible.



The staff finds your reasons for extension of the schedule to be justified and grants an extension of time to implement the upgraded emergency operating procedures to March 31, 1986. The Commission's Order of February 23, 1984, is considered to be changed in respect to this specific implementation date.
