**PROGRAM INFORMATION: DRAFT RULE -- FEE RECOVERY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2001  
(STP-01- 031) (REVISED)**

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) would like to inform the Agreement States of a proposed rulemaking to 10 CFR Parts 170 and 171 regarding the licensing, inspection, and annual fees to recover approximately 98 percent of its fiscal year (FY) 2001 budget authority. The amendments are necessary in order to implement the Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1990 (OBRA-90), as amended, which mandates that NRC recover through fees approximately 98 percent of its FY 2001 budget authority, less the amount appropriated from the Department of Energy administered Nuclear Waste Fund. The proposed rule would modify the fees currently assessed to those Agreement States licensees who perform work in Non-Agreement States under the reciprocity provisions of 10 CFR 150.20. The proposed rule was published in the *Federal Register* on March 28, 2001 (66 FR 16982). The *Federal Register* notice requests comments by April 27, 2001.

The proposed rule was sent to each State under separate cover, with a memorandum summarizing the proposed changes. The discussion of the proposed change to the reciprocity fee can be found on page 7 of the copy of the proposed rule that was mailed to the States, and on page 16984 of the March 28, 2001, *Federal Register*. You may wish to inform your licensees of this change.
