On November 18, 1993, the Commission issued Amendment Nos. 157 and 151 to Facility Operating License Nos. DPR-31 and DPR-41 for the Turkey Point Plant, Unit Nos. 3 and 4, respectively. The amendments consisted of changes to the Technical Specifications (TS) in response to your application dated July 20, 1993 to implement new 10 CFR 20 requirements relating to radiological effluent releases.

Our November 18, 1993 letter provided instructions to remove the existing TS pages and replace them with the revised TS pages. This instruction page included a typographical error. A revised instruction page is enclosed.
