Dear Mr. Goldberg:

On October 12, 1994, the Commission issued Amendment Nos. 167 and 161 to Facility Operating License Nos. DPR-31 and DPR-41 for the Turkey Point Plant, Unit Nos. 3 and 4, respectively. The amendments consisted of changes to the Technical Specifications (TS) in response to your application dated July 19, 1994 to relocate the rod bank insertion limits and K(Z) curve to the Core Operating Limits Report.

Our October 12, 1994 letter provided instructions to remove the existing TS pages and replace them with the revised TS pages. Page 6-20a was incorrectly numbered as page 6-21. The correct page is provided by this letter. Please replace page 6-20a with the attached page and retain the page 6-21 issued by Amendments 153 and 148 on January 8, 1993.

SPECIAL REPORTS

6.9.2 Special reports shall be submitted to the Regional Administrator of the Regional Office of the NRC within the time period specified for each report as stated in the Specifications within Sections 3.0, 4.0, or 5.0.

6.10 RECORD RETENTION

6.10.1 In addition to the applicable record retention requirements of Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, the following records shall be retained for at least the minimum period indicated.

6.10.2 The following records shall be retained for at least 5 years:

- a. Records and logs of unit operation covering time interval at each power level;
- b. Records and logs of principal maintenance activities, inspections, repair, and replacement of principal items of equipment related to nuclear safety;
- c. ALL REPORTABLE EVENTS;
- d. Records of surveillance activities, inspections, and calibrations required by these Technical Specifications;
- e. Records of changes made to the procedures required by Specification 6.8.1;
- f. Records of radioactive shipments;
- g. Records of sealed source and fission detector leak tests and results; and
- h. Records of annual physical inventory of all sealed source material of record.

6.10.3 The following records shall be retained for the duration of the unit Operating License:
