Dear Mr. Stewart:

The Commission has issued the enclosed Amendment No. 76 and No. 65 to Facility Operating License No. NPF-4 and No. NPF-7 for the North Anna Power Station, Units No. 1 and No. 2 (NA-1&2). The amendments add a License Condition in response to your letter dated July 13, 1982, as supplemented by letters dated October 21, 1982, June 16, July 19, July 25, September 13, October 28, November 10, November 23, December 6, 1983, and April 10, May 8, and May 18, 1984. The amendments are effective as of the date of issuance.

The amendments allow for the receipt and storage of 500 spent fuel assemblies from the Surry Power Station, Units No. 1 and No. 2 (Surry 1&2) at NA-1&2.

The amendments add License Conditions 2.D(4) and 2.C(22) to the operating licenses for NA-1&2, respectively. The new License Conditions stipulate the provisions for the allowance of the receipt and storage of Surry 1&2 spent fuel at NA-1&2. New License Conditions 2.D.(4) and 2.C.(22) for NA-1&2, specify that the Surry 1&2 spent fuel shall not be enriched to more than 4.1% by weight U-235 subject to the following conditions: (a) Surry fuel assemblies may not be placed in the NA-1&2 reactors; (b) irradiated fuel shipped to NA-1&2 shall have been removed from the Surry 1&2 reactors no less than 730 days prior to shipment, and (c) no more than 500 Surry 1&2 irradiated fuel assemblies shall be received for storage at the NA-1&2 spent fuel pool.


