SUBJECT: EXTENSION OF CONSTRUCTION COMPLETION DATES, NORTH ANNA POWER STATION, UNITS 1 & 2

By your letter, dated January 7, 1977, you requested extension of the latest construction completion dates for the North Anna Power Station, Units 1 & 2, CPPR-77 and CPPR-78, respectively. In order to act on your request, we need information clarifying, detailing and justifying the reasons why the construction could not be completed on schedule. Pursuant to 10 CFR Section 50.55(b), you must show good cause why the NRC should extend the completion date for the North Anna Power Station Units 1 and 2, and why the extension time requested is reasonable. Therefore, for each delay provide: 1) the nature and cause of the delay and 2) the time interval of the delay. Furthermore, provide the bases for extending the construction completion dates for North Anna Units 1 and 2 by the time period requested stating particularly the time periods necessary to compensate for each delay. In addition, please advise us whether a significant hazard or a significant change in environmental impact is involved, and the basis for reaching that conclusion.

When this information, which should be submitted no later than 15 days prior to the expiration date, has been received and satisfactorily reviewed, we will be able to complete our review of your request for extensions.

Our records indicate that the latest construction completion dates for CPPR-77 and CPPR-78 will expire on March 1, 1977 and May 1, 1978, respectively.
