SUBJECT: COMPLETION OF LICENSE CONDITION 2.C.(16) TO FACILITY OPERATING LICENSE NPF-7 ISSUED AUGUST 21, 1980 FOR THE NORTH ANNA POWER STATION, UNIT NO. 2 (NA-2).

License Condition 2.C.(16) to facility operating license NPF-7 for NA-2 stipulates, "Within 90 days following issuance of the pending revision of Regulatory Guide 1.97, "Instrumentation for Light-Water-Cooled Nuclear Plants to Assess Plant Conditions During and Following an Accident", VEPCO shall provide a schedule acceptable to the NRC for bringing this facility in compliance with Regulatory Guide 1.97, as revised".

Regulatory Guide 1.97, Revision 2, was issued December 23, 1980 and your submittal dated March 20, 1981, (Serial No. 191) providing a schedule for bringing NA-2 in compliance with this Guide meets the time requirements set forth in Condition 2.C.(16).

Also, we have reviewed your submittal and find that your schedule for implementation of Regulatory Guide 1.97, Revision 2, meets the provisions of the guide, except as modified by NUREG-0737 and the Commission Memorandum and Order (CLI-80-21), by June, 1983. Therefore, we find your submittal adequate for meeting the requirements set forth in Condition 2.C.(16) to Facility Operating License, NPF-7.
