We have received the enclosed Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) correspondence dated November 14, 2001, transmitting the FEMA final exercise report for the July 10-11, 2001 biennial radiological emergency preparedness exercise at the Donald C. Cook Nuclear Power Plant.

No deficiencies were identified during the exercise. However, one Area Requiring Corrective Action (ARCA) was identified.

We fully recognize that any corrective actions to be implemented may involve parties and political institutions which are not under your direct control. Nonetheless, we expect that assistance, if appropriate, will be extended.
