ORDER EXTENDING PROVISIONAL CONSTRUCTION PERMIT COMPLETION DATE

By application dated March 27, 1972, the Tennessee Valley Authority requested an extension of the latest completion date specified in Provisional Construction Permit No. CPPR-29. The permit authorizes the construction of a single cycle, forced circulation, boiling water nuclear reactor, known as the Browns Ferry Nuclear Power Station Unit No. 1, on the Tennessee Valley Authority's site at Wheeler Lake, Limestone County, Alabama, about ten miles southwest of Athens, Alabama.

Good cause having been shown for this extension pursuant to Section 185 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, and Section 50.55(b) of 10 CFR Part 50 of the Commission's regulations, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT the latest completion date specified in Provisional Construction Permit No. CPPR-29 is extended from April 15, 1972 to December 31, 1972.
