 - (2) Background investigation since last access
 - (3) Pre-access testing
 - (4) Training

§26.20 Reinstatement

- (a) Applicable to individuals who have had UAA within the past 365 days
- (b) Requirements
 - (1) Self disclosure
 - (2) Background investigation since last access
 - (3) Pre-access test
 - If 30 days or less, no FFD sample taken
 - If more than 30 days, sample taken, but results not needed
 - (4) Verify training
