Dear Mr. White:

The NRC issued an Order entitled, "Order Modifying Licenses (Effective Immediately)," on January 30, 1986, which addressed records of the Quality Technology Corporation (QTC) resulting from your Employee Concern Program. Section V(A) of the Order, among other things, directed that TVA prohibit the removal or destruction of the unexpurgated original QTC records resulting from the Employee Concern Program from TVA controlled property without the prior approval of the Director, Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation. Section V(B) of the Order required TVA to provide five working days notice before QTC relinquishes control or custody of the unexpurgated records. Section V of the Order also provided that the Director could relax or terminate the conditions of the Order.

In issuing this Order, it was our intent that appropriate copies of the original records would be made before permitting removal of the records. We recognized that, if there was a need to further review or copy the records, they might not be at the Watts Bar site. The location of the records is a matter of contract between TVA and QTC. However, until authorization for the destruction of the records is given under Section V(A) of the Order, the records are to remain intact and be available for inspection and copying under Section V(C) of the Order. In addition, regardless of the location of the records, Section V(B) of the Order requires notice to the Director before QTC relinquishes control or custody of the records. Destruction or other action to compromise the integrity of the records would constitute relinquishing control or custody under Section V(B) of the Order.

NRC has now completed making copies of the original QTC records. Subject to further review and investigations these copies should be sufficient for our regulatory needs. Therefore, there is no longer a need by NRC for the original records to remain on site. But as indicated above, we may need at a later time to further inspect and copy the original records. Accordingly, in accordance with Section V of the Order, the prohibition on removal of the original records from TVA controlled property under Section V(A) of the Order is hereby rescinded subject to the condition that TVA keeps NRC informed of the location of the original records. All other provisions of the Order remain in effect including those related to destruction, notice, access, and
