SUBJECT: BROWNS FERRY NUCLEAR PLANT, UNITS 1, 2 AND 3 - EXEMPTION FROM
CRITICALITY ACCIDENT MONITORING REQUIREMENTS (TAC NOS. M97301,
M97302 AND M97303)

Dear Mr. Scalice:

By letter dated November 22, 1996 and its supplements, you requested an exemption from the *Title 10 Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) Section 70.24 relating to criticality accident monitoring requirements. On November 12, 1998, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission noticed in the *Federal Register* that it is amending 10 CFR 70.2. The final rule became effective from December 14, 1998 (see 63 FR 63127). In view of the revised regulations, by letter dated November 19, 1998, we requested that you reconsider your exemption request. Upon reconsideration, you have determined that you will be in compliance with the new regulations, and exemption from 10 CFR 70.24 is no longer required. Accordingly, by letter dated December 15, 1998, you withdrew your exemption request. Thus your November 22, 1996 application for exemption is considered withdrawn, and our review effort under technical assignment control (TAC) Nos. M97301, M97302, and M97303 is considered complete and the TACs are closed..
