

SUBJECT: NOTICE OF CONSIDERATION OF ISSUANCE OF AMENDMENT TO FACILITY  
OPERATING LICENSE AND OPPORTUNITY FOR A HEARING (TAC NO. 77277)

Enclosed is the subject notice related to your license amendment request (TS-292) for Browns Ferry Nuclear Plant, Unit 2 (BFN2) dated August 7, 1990 as supplemented November 30, 1990. The application for license amendment proposed changes to the BFN2 Technical Specifications (TS) surveillance requirements of TS Section 4.11.B.1.f for the electric and diesel-driven fire pumps. New values for flow and system head pressure have also been proposed. Along with these changes, the Bases of TS Section 3.11 would be revised to indicate the availability of a backup fire pump should the high pressure fire pumps become inoperable.

This notice is being forwarded to the Office of the Federal Register for publication.
