Gentlemen:

The Commission has issued the enclosed Amendment No. 13 to Facility License No. DPR-62 for the Brunswick Steam Electric Plant, Unit 2. This amendment is in response to your request dated November 3, 1975.

This amendment corrects typographical errors and clarifies items in the Environmental Technical Specifications. No technical changes were made.

We have evaluated the potential for environmental impact of plant operation in accordance with the enclosed amendment. The amendment applies to administrative details only. We have determined that the amendment does not authorize a change in effluent types or total amounts nor an increase in power level, and will not result in any significant environmental impact. Having made this determination, we have further concluded that the amendment involves an action which is insignificant from the standpoint of environmental impact and pursuant to 10 CFR § 51.5(d)(4) that an environmental statement, negative declaration or environmental impact appraisal need not be prepared in connection with the issuance of this amendment.

Since the amendment applies only to administrative details to correct typographical errors and to clarify items in the Environmental Technical Specifications, it does not involve significant new safety information of a type not considered by a previous Commission safety review of the facility. It does not involve a significant increase in the probability or consequences of an accident, does not involve a significant decrease in a safety margin and, therefore, does not involve a significant hazards consideration. We have also concluded that there is reasonable assurance that the health and safety of the public will not be endangered by this action.

AMENDMENT TO FACILITY OPERATING LICENSE

1. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) has found that:
 - A. The application for amendment by Carolina Power and Light Company (the licensee) dated November 3, 1975, complies with the standards and requirements of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, (the Act) and the Commission's rules and regulations set forth in 10 CFR Chapter I;
 - B. The facility will operate in conformity with the application, the provisions of the Act, and the rules and regulations of the Commission;
 - C. There is reasonable assurance (i) that the activities authorized by this amendment can be conducted without endangering the health and safety of the public, and (ii) that such activities will be conducted in compliance with the Commission's regulations;
 - D. The issuance of this amendment will not be inimical to the common defense and security or to the health and safety of the public; and
 - E. An environmental statement or negative declaration need not be prepared in connection with the issuance of this amendment.
2. Accordingly, the license is amended by a change to the Technical Specifications as indicated in the attachment to this license amendment.

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3. This license amendment is effective as of its issuance.

NOTICE OF ISSUANCE OF AMENDMENT TO FACILITY

OPERATING LICENSE

Notice is hereby given that the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) has issued Amendment No. 13 to Facility Operating License No. DPR-62 issued to Carolina Power and Light Company which revised Technical Specifications for operation of the Brunswick Steam Electric Plant, Unit 2, located in Brunswick County, North Carolina. The amendment is effective as of its date of issuance.

The amendment corrects typographical errors and clarifies items in the Environmental Technical Specifications. No technical changes were made.

The application for the amendment complies with the standards and requirements of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended (the Act), and the Commission's rules and regulations. The Commission has made appropriate findings as required by the Act and the Commission's rules and regulations in 10 CFR Chapter I, which are set forth in the license amendment. Prior public notice of this amendment is not required since the amendment does not involve a significant hazards consideration.

The Commission has determined that the issuance of this amendment will not result in any significant environmental impact and that pursuant to 10 CFR §1.5(d)(4) an environmental statement, negative declaration or

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environmental impact appraisal need not be prepared in connection with issuance of this amendment.
