Dear Dr. Apostolakis:

In a letter dated December 12, 2001, the Committee stated that the proposed rulemaking for risk-informed revisions to 10 CFR 50.44 would provide more effective and efficient regulation to deal with combustible gases in containment. The staff appreciates the Committee's encouraging remarks and positive views on the staff's efforts on this rulemaking.

In addition, the Committee recommended that the proposed specification for the combustible gas source term for boiling water reactor (BWR) Mark III and pressurized water reactor (PWR) ice condenser containment be included in the draft regulatory guide (DG-1117) instead of being retained in the proposed rule. With the Commission's approval, the staff will issue the proposed rule for public review and comment. The staff will continue to consider this recommendation during our consideration of stakeholder comments and suggestions.
