27 Skadden, Arps, Slate, Meagher & Flom LLP (the "Firm") submits its Cover Sheet
28 Application (the "Application") for Allowance and Payment of Interim Compensation and
29 Reimbursement of Expenses for the Period October 1, 2001 through October 31, 2001 (the
30 "Application Period"). In support of the Application, the Firm respectfully represents as follows:

31 1. The Firm is special regulatory counsel to Pacific Gas and Electric
32 Company, the debtor and debtor in possession in the above-referenced bankruptcy case (the
33 "Debtor"). The Firm hereby applies to the Court for allowance and payment of interim

2 Application Period.

3 2. The Firm billed a total of \$410,790.87 in fees and expenses during the
4 Application Period. The total fees represent 1,264.80 hours expended during the period covered
5 by this Application. These fees and expenses break down as follows:

10 3. Accordingly, the Firm seeks allowance of interim compensation in the
11 total amount of \$351,118.17 at this time. This total is comprised as follows: \$338,145.30 (85%
12 of the fees for services rendered)¹ plus \$12,972.87 (100% of the expenses incurred).

7. The Firm has served a copy of this Application on the Special Notice List in this case.

8. In accordance with this Court's "ORDER ESTABLISHING INTERIM FEE APPLICATION AND EXPENSE REIMBURSEMENT PROCEDURE" which was entered on or about July 25, 2001, the Debtor is authorized to make the payment requested herein without a further hearing or order of this Court unless an objection to this Application is filed with the Court by the Debtor, the Committee or the United States Trustee and served by the fifteenth day of the month following the service of this Application. If such an objection is filed, Debtor is authorized to pay the amounts, if any, not subject to the objection. The Firm is informed and believes that this Cover Sheet Application was mailed by first class mail, postage prepaid, on or about December 27, 2001.

9. The interim compensation and reimbursement of expenses sought in this Application is on account and is not final. Upon the conclusion of this case, the Firm will seek

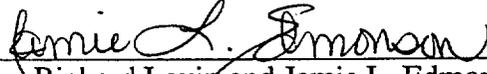
1 fees and reimbursement of the expenses incurred for the totality of the services rendered in this
2 case. Any interim fees or reimbursement of expenses approved by this Court and received by the
3 Firm will be credited against such final fees and expenses as may be allowed by this Court.

4 10. The Firm represents and warrants that its billing practices comply with all
5 Northern District of California Bankruptcy Local Rules and Compensation Guidelines and the
6 Guidelines of the Office of the United States Trustee. Neither the Firm nor any members of the
7 Firm has any agreement or understanding of any kind or nature to divide, pay over or share any
8 portion of the fees or expenses to be awarded to the Firm with any other person or attorney
9 except as among the members and associates of the Firm.

10 WHEREFORE, the Firm respectfully requests that the Debtor pay compensation
11 to the Firm as requested herein in accordance with the terms of the "ORDER ESTABLISHING
12 INTERIM FEE APPLICATION AND EXPENSE REIMBURSEMENT PROCEDURE."
