Subject: Comments on Final Criticality Accident Requirements Rule -Reply

After reviewing the proposed criteria for 10CFR50.68, I believe that it would be advantageous to rewrite criterion (1) as follows:

(1) Plant procedures during fuel handling and transportation do not permit the assemblage of a critical configuration of fuel assemblies, considering the most adverse conditions of geometry and moderation by unborated water possible.

This would eliminate possible exemption requirements for licensees who may have sufficient assemblies out of safe storage to achieve a critical configuration but who have either sufficient separation distances or the absence of sources of moderation to preclude criticality.
