PRELIMINARY RESPONSE TO  
NRC INSPECTION REPORTS 50-266/01-12 (DRS) AND 50-301/01-12 (DRS)  
POINT BEACH NUCLEAR PLANT UNITS 1 AND 2

Reference: Letter from R.N. Gardner (NMC) to M.E. Reddemann (NRC) dated November 13, 2001.

On November 13, 2001, the referenced inspection report was transmitted to the Nuclear Management Company, LLC (NMC). The inspection report documented the results of the Triennial Fire Protection Inspection, conducted at Point Beach Nuclear Plant (PBNP) from September 10 through 28, 2001.

The report identified three non-cited violations (NCVs) and one inspection finding. One of these findings stated the automatic fire suppression system for the auxiliary feedwater pump room was not adequate. The finding states the installed fire suppression system was only designed for surface fires and was not designed to provide the necessary soak time for deep-seated fires. However, deep-seated fire hazards have been introduced to the room. 10 CFR Part 50, Appendix R, Section III.G.2 is cited as the basis for this violation of NRC requirements.

Your letter dated November 13, 2001, states that if NMC denies a non-cited violation that the basis for our denial should be submitted to the NRC within 30 days of this inspection report. Due to the complexity of this issue, we are requesting a 30-day extension to complete our response to this item. Accordingly, we will submit our detailed response on this finding by January 13, 2002.
