The referenced letter transmitted the results of NRC Inspection Report No. 50-361/01-19; 50-362/01-19, conducted August 20 through August 24, 2001, at the San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station (SONGS), Units 2 and 3. The enclosure to the referenced letter described two Severity Level IV non-cited violations (NCV 0119-02 and 0119-03). The letter stated that, if Southern California Edison (SCE) contests any of the violations, then SCE should provide a response within 30 days of the date of the inspection report.

As discussed between Ms. Gail Good, Branch Chief, NRC Region IV, Division of Reactor Safety, Plant Support Branch, and Mr. Geoff Cook of my staff on January 17, 2002, SCE requests a 30-day extension for providing a response to NRC Inspection Report 50-361/01-19; 50-362/01-19.
