




Dear Murray:



Between the time at which a film badge was issued (1-25-73) and the last film badge reading (4-3-75), a total of [redacted] was recorded. This information is also given in quarterly exposures in the enclosed table. Our files show that the film badge number from which the data were obtained was #14, that it belonged to [redacted] social security [redacted] date of birth [redacted] [redacted] worked continuously with radioisotopes (^{125}I , ^{14}C and ^3H) in rooms L 2-37, LC-23 and LC-27 from the time of badge issuance to the final day of employment. 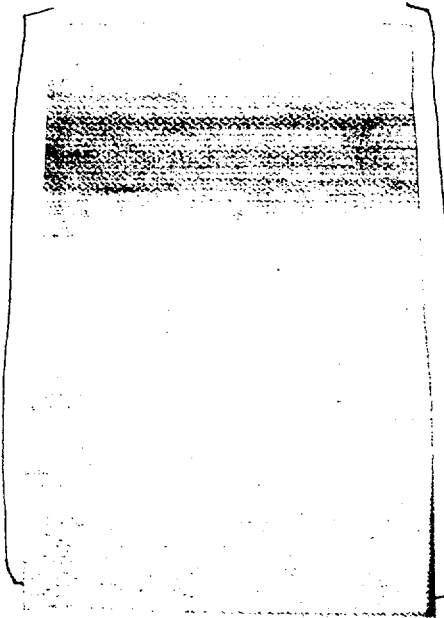
