Notice is hereby given that on January 29, 1975, David M. Stewart, et al., by their attorney, filed a request pursuant to 10 CFR § 2.206 of the Commission's Rules of Practice for the issuance by the Acting Director, Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation of an order to show cause why the Carolina Power & Light Company, Brunswick Steam Electric Plant license should not be amended to require a comprehensive and independent re-evaluation of the seismic safety of the plant site as a continuing condition of the fueling, testing and operation of the Brunswick Plant. In accordance with the procedures specified in 10 CFR § 2.206, appropriate action will be taken on this request within a reasonable time.
