# NOTICE OF CONSIDERATION OF ISSUANCE OF AMENDMENT TO FACILITY OPERATING LICENSE AND PROPOSED NO SIGNIFICANT HAZARDS

### CONSIDERATION DETERMINATION

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) is considering issuance of an amendment to Facility Operating License No. DPR-71, issued to Carolina Power & Light Company (the licensee), for operation of the Brunswick Steam Electric Plant, Unit 1 located in Brunswick County, North Carolina.

The amendment would revise the technical specifications of the operating license to incorporate appropriate limiting conditions for operation of the facility during the fourth fuel cycle. The revised technical specifications would place appropriate restrictions on the rate of heat generation in the nuclear fuel by specifying limiting values of the Linear Heat Generation Rate, Average Planar Linear Heat Generation Rate, Minimum Critical Power Ratio and set points for the Average Power Range Monitoring System. These revisions to the technical specifications would be made in response to the licensee's application for amendment dated May 2, 1983.

Before issuance of the proposed license amendment, the Commission will have made findings required by the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended (the Act) and the Commission's regulations.

The Commission has made a proposed determination that the amendment request involves no significant hazards consideration. Under the Commission's regulations in 10 CFR 50.92, this means that operation of the facility in accordance with the proposed amendment would not (1) involve a significant increase in the probability or consequences of an accident previously evaluated; or (2) create the possibility or a new or different kind of accident from any accident previously evaluated; or (3) involve a significant reduction in a margin of safety.

The Commission has provided guidance for the application of these criteria by providing examples of amendments that are considered not likely to involve significant hazards considerations (48 CFR 14870). One such amendment is a change resulting from a nuclear reactor core reloading, if no fuel assemblies significantly different from those found previously acceptable to the Commission for a previous core at the facility in question are involved.

This third refueling of the Brunswick Steam Electric Plant, Unit 1 involves no fuel assemblies significantly different from those used in a previous refueling and found acceptable to the Commission. Furthermore, there are no significant changes to the acceptance criteria for the technical specifications. The analytical methods used to-demonstrate conformance with the technical specifications and regulations have been found previously acceptable to the Commission. Therefore, based on these considerations and the three criteria given above, we have made a proposed determination that this amendment request involves no significant hazards consideration.

The Commission has determined that failure to act in a timely way would result in extending the shutdown of the facility. Therefore, the Commission has insufficient time to issue its usual 30-day notice of the proposed action for public comment.

If the proposed determination becomes final, an opportunity for a hearing will be published in the Federal Register at a later date and any hearing request will not delay the effective date of the amendment.

If the staff decides in its final determination that the amendment does involve a significant hazards consideration, a notice of opportunity for a prior hearing will be published in the Federal Register and, if a hearing is granted, it will be held before the amendment is issued.

The Commission is seeking public comments on this proposed determination. Comments on the proposed determination may be telephoned to Domenic B.
