Gentlemen:

The Commission has issued the enclosed Amendment No. 3 to Construction Permit No. CPPR-90 for the Edwin I. Hatch Nuclear Plant, Unit No. 2. This amendment is in response to your request dated May 3, 1976, and revises the environmental monitoring reporting frequency from semiannually to annually. This revision to the construction permit for Unit No. 2 will result in an environmental reporting requirement that is compatible with the existing annual report requirements set forth in the Environmental Technical Specifications for Edwin I. Hatch, Unit No. 1. This change will not alter the frequency of measurements nor result in any environmental impacts.

AMENDMENT TO CONSTRUCTION PERMIT

Construction Permit No. CPPR-90
Amendment No. 3

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission has issued Amendment No.3 to Construction Permit No. CPPR-90 by revising paragraph 2.E.(1) in its entirety to read as follows:

" The applicant will perform preoperational measurements of the distributions of aquatic species to establish base-line data adequate for determining adverse effects the plant might have on the environment. An analysis of the results of this program will be reported to the Commission annually."

This amendment is effective as of its issuance date.

NOTICE OF ISSUANCE OF AMENDMENT TO CONSTRUCTION PERMIT

Notice is hereby given that the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) has issued Amendment No. 3 to Construction Permit No. CPPR-90 issued to Georgia Power Company for construction of the Edwin I. Hatch Nuclear Plant, Unit 2, located at the Permittee's site near the south bank of the Altamaha River in Appling County, Georgia.

The amendment changes the frequency of submittal of results of the environmental monitoring program from semiannually to annually. This revision to the construction permit for Unit No. 2 will result in an environmental reporting requirement that is compatible with the existing annual report requirements set forth in the Environmental Technical Specifications for Edwin I. Hatch Unit No. 1. This change will not alter the frequency of measurements nor result in any environmental impacts.

The application for the amendment complies with the standards and requirements of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended (the Act), and the Commission's rules and regulations. Prior public notice of this amendment is not required since the amendment does not involve a significant hazards consideration.
