In response to your December 14, 2001, letter requesting the permanent transfer of 197 cubic feet of U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) records currently stored at the Washington National Record Center (WNRC) in Suitland, Maryland, to your facility in College Park, Maryland, we have disapproved the transfer for the following reasons:

- Accession number 431-93-F0009 totaling, 4 cubic feet, was permanently withdrawn from storage at the WNRC on October 21, 1999.
- Accession numbers 431-94-0106 and 431-94-0107, totaling 21 cubic feet, disposition dates are not until 2006 and 2005, respectively.
- Accession numbers 431-86-0188 and 431-86-0080B, totaling 144 cubic feet, are continually being accessed by Commission legal assistants and staff involved with active adjudications.
- Accession numbers 431-86-0185, 431-86-0186, and 431-86-0187, totaling 28 cubic feet, must be retained at the agency for the life of the Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards (ACRS) and the Advisory Committee on Nuclear Waster (ACNW). As a result of an agreement with NARA and the WNRC, these records will be reviewed at ten year intervals as long as the ACRS and ACNW exist.
