
In light of the disaster of September 11th, the Hastings-on-Hudson School District is taking a critical look at all safety plans and procedures concerning our entire school population, students as well as staff and personnel.


As a school board we are charged with providing a safe and healthful environment for the children of our school district. To that end, we feel the need to have more information about the safety measures and evacuation and medical plans that are in place in the greater region surrounding the Indian Point nuclear power plant. Our district is located within twenty-five miles of the plant and we have students attending schools in out-of-district locations that are within ten miles of the plant.


We have serious concerns about the scope of the current evacuation and medical plans and the preventative measures which would eliminate the risk of nuclear disaster should the plant become the target of an attack or sustain a serious malfunction. At a time when the safety and security of our school community may be threatened, we feel it is urgent that we become fully informed of all the resources at our disposal for maintaining a safe and secure environment.


We appreciate your prompt attention to our concerns and are looking forward to receiving the information that is critical to our understanding of the safety procedures in place.


