Dear Mr. LaFranzo,

As requested by your organization in response to the NRC Temporary Instruction 2800/030, I am providing you with a list of radioactive exit signs purchased by United Airlines and installed at the Indianapolis Maintenance Center (IMC). I originally informed you during a telephone conversation that there were probably 12 radioactive signs at the IMC. This statement was based on information obtained from one of our facility maintenance personnel. However, after reviewing our records and conducting a facility wide survey, we found that only six signs containing radioactive material were purchased for the IMC. These signs are installed in six of our aircraft maintenance hangars. The exit signs were purchased from Safety Light Corporation in Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania. All signs are the same brand, Isolite, Model # 2040 with a 7.5 curies tritium source.

The following table contains the location of these signs:


