SUBJECT: PILGRIM NUCLEAR POWER STATION - REQUEST FOR WITHHOLDING  
INFORMATION FROM PUBLIC DISCLOSURE (TAC NO. MB2843)

Dear Mr. Bellamy:

By your application dated February 15, 2002, and affidavit dated February 15, 2002, executed by you, you submitted Enclosure 1 Attachment A.1, "Spreadsheet of 5 Year Projection" and requested that it be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) Section 2.790. A nonproprietary copy of this document has been placed in the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC's) Public Document Room and added to the Agencywide Documents Access and Management System Public Electronic Reading Room.

The affidavit stated that the submitted information should be considered exempt from mandatory public disclosure for the following reasons:

- i. This information is of a type that is held in confidence by Entergy Nuclear, and there is a rational basis for doing so because the information contains sensitive financial information concerning Entergy Nuclear's projected revenues and operating expenses.
- ii. Public disclosure of this information would create substantial harm to the competitive position of Entergy Nuclear by disclosing Entergy Nuclear's internal financial projections and the commercial terms of a unique transaction to other parties whose commercial interests may be adverse to those of Entergy Nuclear.

We have reviewed your application and the material in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 2.790 and, on the basis of your statements, have determined that the submitted information sought to be withheld contains proprietary commercial information and should be withheld from public disclosure.

Therefore, the version of the submitted information marked as proprietary will be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to 10 CFR 2.790(b)(5) and Section 103(b) of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended.

Withholding from public inspection shall not affect the right, if any, of persons properly and directly concerned to inspect the documents. If the need arises, we may send copies of this information to our consultants working in this area. We will, of course, ensure that the consultants have signed the appropriate agreements for handling proprietary information.
