This refers to the public exit meeting conducted in the Callaway Plant Emergency Operations Facility on February 27, 2002. This meeting was held to discuss performance issues identified during the augmented inspection team conducted between January 28 and February 6, 2002. The inspection was performed to evaluate the root causes and corrective actions associated with the failure of an auxiliary feedwater pump on December 3, 2001.
