Our percentage of population tested from January 1, 2001 to December 31, 2001 was 53.55%.

Three of the positive Marijuana drug test results were below the DHHS/NRC initial screening level of 100 NG/ML. Our initial Screening level for Marijuana is 50 NG/ML.
