This amendment is in response to a Florida Power Company (FPC) request dated November 24, 1998, and supplemented on June 23, 1999. The FPC submittal requested approval for the addition of a safety-related diesel-driven emergency feedwater pump (EFP-3) as a functional replacement for the existing motor-driven pump, addition of technical specifications and surveillances for this new pump, and deletion of cycle specific interim technical specifications which would not be required after the addition of the new pump.

A copy of the related Safety Evaluation is also enclosed. The Notice of Issuance will be included in the Commission's biweekly <u>Federal Register</u> notice.
