Dear Sir:

By letter dated December 29, 1998, Florida Power Corporation (FPC) submitted a request for NRC consent to the proposed transfer of the City of Tallahassee's 1.3333 percent undivided ownership in, and entitlement to 11.4 megawatts of output of the Crystal River Unit 3 (CR-3) nuclear plant to FPC. In response to NRC's request for additional information, this correspondence provides the basis for the decision to have the City of Tallahassee retain control of its decommissioning trust fund rather than transferring the City's funds to FPC.

FPC believes that the funds available at the time of decommissioning will be greatest if the City retains the funds in its decommissioning trust. Given the City's tax exempt status, FPC expects that the earnings in the City's fund will accrue at a rate greater than the rate if the funds were transferred to FPC. Additionally, retention of the funds by the City will avoid potential adverse tax consequences that may occur if the City's funds were transferred to FPC's decommissioning trust fund.
