The Rules and Directives Branch (RDB), Office of Administration (ADM), requires your comments to prepare the NRC's 2002 Regulatory Plan. Attached is a copy of the 2001 Regulatory Plan for your information and guidance for preparing the latest regulatory plan. Please update the entries for any rules related to your office. Also, please include an entry for each new rule your office plans to issue in FY 2002 if the rule meets the criteria for inclusion.

Under Executive Order 12866 (copy attached), each agency is required to develop a regulatory plan that provides basic information concerning the most significant regulatory actions that an agency reasonably expects to issue in proposed or final form in the upcoming fiscal year (see Sec. 3(f) of the Order). The regulatory plan is to serve as a defining statement of the Administration's regulatory policies and priorities.

The regulatory plan contains Parts A and B. Part A consists of ADM's narrative statement of NRC's regulatory priorities. Part B contains the entries from the program offices.

The Office of Information and Regulatory Affairs, Office of Management and Budget, forwards each plan to the Vice President, regulatory policy advisors, and affected agencies to ensure that the anticipated regulatory actions of one agency do not conflict with or duplicate those of another agency.
