Yesterday I got an email from the staff about the issue. I will forward their email and my response for your info. The bottom line is that the staff said that ConEd never told them about a crack during some phone calls held in May and June. However, a July 29, 1997 report did include the information. The question is whether or not the licensee deliberately did not inform the staff so that the outage would not be extended to deal with the crack. Since this is plant specific, I think it probably belongs to you anyway, but I'm trying to find out if it's really an allegation. Seems to me it would be difficult to find a deliberate attempt to deceive if they informed us of the finding one month later. After you get the mails, let maknow what you think.

I have no knowledge of us looking into this in a previous allegation.
