1. MANAGEMENT SUMMARY

A. RANDOM TESTING

During this reporting period, Consumers Energy* conducted a total of 281 random tests with the following results:

B. PRE-ACCESS TESTING

A total of 235 pre-access tests were conducted during this reporting period. Four (4) individuals were denied access based on positive test results.

C. FOR CAUSE TESTING

One (1) For-Cause test was administered during the reporting period resulting from a security officer discovering an open container of alcohol in an employee's vehicle. The test results were negative.
