Subject: Issuance of Amendment No. 2 to Construction Permit CPPR-87 -
Enrico Fermi Atomic Power Plant, Unit No. 2 (Facility)

Enclosed is Amendment No. 2 to CPPR-87 reflecting a change in ownership and a copy of a related notice which has been forwarded to the Office of the Federal Register for publication. Amendment No. 2 will be effective as of the date of issuance.

Your letter, dated August 13, 1982, transmitted an application for an amendment to the Enrico Fermi Atomic Power Plant, Unit No. 2 Construction Permit, CPPR-87, dated August 11, 1982. This application requested Commission approval to merge Michigan Electric Cooperative, Inc. (Northern) into Wolverine Electric Cooperative, Incorporated (Wolverine), and to transfer Northern's interest in the facility to Wolverine. You further requested an amendment to the Construction Permit to reflect the name of the merged organization following consummation of the merger. The Detroit Edison Company will retain 80 percent ownership shares as well as sole responsibility for licensing, design, procurement, construction, operation and all related functions with respect to the facility.

Based on our review of the application, we conclude that granting the requested amendment does not involve a significant hazards consideration, and is not inimical to the health and safety of the public. The bases for these conclusions are set forth in the enclosed Safety Evaluation. Prior public notice of changes to safety matters resulting from the amendment was not required since the amendment does not involve a significant hazards consideration.

We have also concluded that the amendment involves actions which are insignificant from the standpoint of environmental impact and that, pursuant to 10 CFR Section 51.5(d)(4), an environmental impact statement, or a negative declaration and an environmental impact appraisal, need not be prepared in connection with the issuance of the amendment.

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Accordingly, the Commission approves the merger of Northern Michigan Electric Cooperative, Inc. into Wolverine Electric Cooperative, Inc. in accordance with the Agreement and Plan for Reorganization, dated June 16, 1982, and attached to the application for amendment to the construction permit.

AMENDMENT TO CONSTRUCTION PERMIT

Amendment No. 2

Construction Permit No. CPPR-87

1. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) having found that:
 - A. The application for amendment to Construction Permit No. CPPR-87, dated August 11, 1982 by The Detroit Edison Company, Northern Michigan Electric Cooperative, Inc., and Wolverine Electric Cooperative, Incorporated, complies with the standards and requirements of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended (the Act), and the Commission's rules and regulations set forth in 10 CFR Chapter I;
 - B. The issuance of this amendment will not be inimical to the common defense and security or to the health and safety of the public;
 - C. There is reasonable assurance (i) that the activities authorized by this amendment can be conducted without endangering the health and safety of the public and (ii) that such activities will be conducted in accordance with the Commission's regulations.
 - D. The issuance of this amendment is in accordance with 10 CFR Part 51 of the Commission's regulations and all applicable requirements have been satisfied.
2. Accordingly, Construction Permit No. CPPR-87, is hereby amended to reflect a change in title of the part owner of the facility.

New paragraphs are added as follows:

2.E. After the merger of Northern Michigan Electric Cooperative, Inc. into Wolverine Electric Cooperative, Incorporated, the name Northern Michigan Electric Cooperative, Inc. will be deleted as owner and participant in the Enrico Fermi Atomic Power Plant,

Unit No. 2, and the name Wolverine Electric Cooperative, Incorporated will be changed to Wolverine Power Supply Cooperative, Inc.

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2.F. After the merger is completed, the 11.22 percent interest from Northern Michigan Electric Cooperative, Inc. will be transferred to Wolverine Power Supply Cooperative, Inc.

Ownership Shares for the Enrico Fermi Atomic Power Plant, Unit No. 2 will then be distributed as follows:

Wolverine Power Supply Cooperative, Inc.	20.00%
The Detroit Edison Company	80.00%

3. This amendment is effective as of the date of issuance.

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SAFETY EVALUATION

SUPPORTING AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO CPPR-87

ENRICO FERMI ATOMIC POWER PLANT, UNIT 2

Introduction

Construction Permit No. CPPR-87 for Fermi 2 was issued to The Detroit Edison Company (Detroit Edison) on September 26, 1972.

Amendment No. 1 to CPPR-87 was issued July 5, 1978 to provide for the addition of the Northern Michigan Electric Cooperative, Inc. (Northern) and the Wolverine Electric Cooperative, Inc. (Wolverine) as co-owners of the facility and as applicants for all licenses previously requested. The ownership shares were apportioned as follows: Detroit Edison, 80.00 percent; Northern, 11.22 percent; Wolverine, 8.78 percent. Detroit Edison had sole responsibility for licensing, design, procurement, construction, operation and all related functions with respect to the facility.

By letter, dated August 13, 1982, Detroit Edison requested Commission approval of the merger of Wolverine and Northern's interests in the Fermi 2 facility into a new cooperative. Applicants also requested an amendment of the construction permit following consummation of the merger to reflect the name of the new organization, Wolverine Power Supply Cooperative, Inc. (WPSC).

Evaluation

An Agreement and Plan of Reorganization (Agreement) dated June 16, 1982 and signed by the President of each cooperative was attached to the amendment application. Under the Agreement, WPSC, the merged organization, will succeed to Northern's rights and obligations. Following consummation of the merger, ownership shares in Fermi 2 will be apportioned as follows: Detroit Edison Company, 80 percent; Wolverine Power Supply Cooperative, Inc., 20 percent. Detroit Edison will retain responsibility for licensing, design, procurement, construction, operation and all related functions with respect to the facility. There will be no substantive change in overall ownership of the Fermi 2 facility.

Conclusions

Our review of the request for the merger of the two co-owners of the Fermi 2 facility has resulted in the conclusion that the activities authorized by this amendment to the Construction Permit would not involve a significant hazards consideration inasmuch as it involves no increase in the probability

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of an accident, no increase in the consequences of an accident, nor a decrease in safety margins. Since a merger in accordance with the Agreement will not result in any divestiture of ownership or responsibility, we conclude that the merger is acceptable. We conclude, therefore, that the activities authorized by this amendment would not constitute an unreasonable risk to the health and safety of the public.

The application for amendment to the construction permit states that Wolverine Power Supply Cooperative will not be owned, controlled or dominated by an alien, a foreign corporation, or a foreign government. We conclude that the activities authorized by this amendment will not be inimical to the common defense and security.

NOTICE OF ISSUANCE OF AMENDMENT TO CONSTRUCTION PERMIT

ENRICO FERMI ATOMIC POWER PLANT, UNIT NO. 2

The U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) has issued Amendment No. 2 to Construction Permit No. CPPR-87 for Fermi 2. The Amendment approves the merger of two co-owners and transfer of shares. Northern Michigan Electric Cooperative, Inc., will merge into Wolverine Electric Cooperative, Incorporated and transfer all its ownership shares (11.22 percent) to the merged organization. The merged organization will be named Wolverine Power Supply Cooperative, Inc. and will own 20 percent ownership shares while The Detroit Edison Company will retain 80 percent ownership shares. Detroit Edison Company will retain sole responsibility for licensing, design, procurement, construction and operation of the facility. The amendment is effective as of the date of issuance.

The Enrico Fermi Atomic Power Plant, Unit No. 2 (the facility) is located in Frenchtown Township, Monroe County, Michigan.

The application for the amendment complies with the standards and requirements of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended (the Act), and the Commission's rules and regulations. The Commission has made appropriate findings as required by the Act and the Commission's rules and regulations in 10 CFR Chapter I, which

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are set forth in the license amendment. Prior public notice of this amendment was not required since the amendment does not involve a significant hazards consideration.
