
On May 7, 2001 I submitted to you a proposed Revision 16 to our Topical Report SL-TR-1A, S&L Nuclear QA Program. On February 26, 2002 I talked to James Pearson of the NRC staff regarding the submittal.

As stated on page 00-8 of the submittal, the submittal was made in accordance with 10 CFR 50.4(b)(7)(ii). While the existing Topical Report discusses 10 CFR 71 and 10 CFR 72 and while Revision 16 also discusses 10 CFR 76, these portions of the Topical Report are provided to the NRC for information only. S&L does not currently hold either a NRC license or package/cask/gaseous diffusion plant Certificate of Compliance, and has no plans to do so. We do support 10 CFR 71, 10 CFR 72 and 10 CFR 76 licensees and certificate holders. It is the responsibility of these licensees and certificate holders to review this Topical Report against their licensing commitments.

Once I receive your approval letter for the proposed Revision 16, Dr. Paul Wattelet, our Chief Executive Officer and myself will sign SL-TR-1A and submit it to the NRC Document Control Desk as required by 10 CFR 50.4(b)(7)(ii).
