You are cordially invited to attend a public meeting between the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and Southern California Edison on April 16, 2002, at 7:00 p.m. The meeting will be conducted at the San Clemente Inn, 2600 Avenida del Presidente, San Clemente, California. The purpose of the meeting is to discuss the results of a recently completed integrated assessment of performance at San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station Units 2 and 3.

On February 12, 2002, the NRC completed an integrated assessment of performance at San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station Units 2 and 3. This integrated assessment included a review of performance indicators and the results of inspections conducted by the NRC. The assessment period was from April 1 to December 31, 2001.
