The following comments refer to statements made in the October 17, 2001, letter from IUC to Melvyn Leach. All NRC documents which substantiate or do not substantiate statements made by IUC should be placed in the hearing file. If the NRC does not have documents substantiating IUC statements, please so state in the hearing file. The verification documents from NRC are necessary to show that the Molycorp material is different from other material received at the mill site. The following refer to the pages and paragraphs from the October 17, 2001, letter, and the items mentioned should be placed in the hearing file.

Page 2, Paragraph 6. Where does Amendment 10 to Molycorp's Radioactive License issued by the State of California indicate the drummed material has been classified as uranium and thorium source material? The part of Amendment 10 that indicates that the drummed material is a source material needs to be highlighted and placed separately in the hearing file.

Page 4, Paragraph 1, Item 2. The TCLP, STLC and TTLC test results are in Attachment 3. The methodology of the tests for the seventeen metals to verify the reliability of the three tests should be placed in the hearing file. The NRC also needed this information to verify the test result.

Page 4, Paragraph 2. An analysis of a typical bastnasite ore from the ore mined by Molycorp should be placed in the hearing file. This analysis was necessary for the NRC to determine that the lead sludge and drummed material are the same as the mined ore material and to determine that

the lead study is not a processed waste under the RCRA Bevill Amendment

Page 5, Heading "USA/UDEQ Hazardous Waste Protocol" Section 2 and 3. Specific information that drummed material is not a listed hazardous waste is mentioned in the letter, ad that information needs to be placed in the hearing file.

Page 5, Section 2. Any NRC information from California, Utah or Nevada that confirms material is not a listed hazardous waste should be placed in the hearing file.

Page 5, Section 3 A statement is made in the letter that the State of California considers the drummed uranium material to be uranium and thorium source material. A copy, from NRC records, of the document from California that certifies the material is a source material should be placed in the hearing file.

Page 6, Paragraph 2. The NRC documentation confirming the byproduct material is an 11e(2) byproduct should be placed in the hearing file to verify this statement in the letter.

Page 6, Transportation Considerations, Paragraph 1. The DOT classified this drummed material as an "environmentally hazardous substance solid." Any information justifying the DOT classification of the drummed material as hazardous should be placed in the hearing file.

I believe that the all the above material requested from the October 17, 2001, letter is necessary to show that the NRC did or did not perform "due diligence" in analyzing the drummed material request by IUC in their October 17, 2001 letter and to verify or not verify IUC's statements by the governmental agency responsible. If my requested material is not available in NRC files, please so state in the hearing file.
