Response to Regulatory Issue Summary 2000-20

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) issued Regulatory Issue Summary (RIS) 2000-20, "Importance of Industry Providing NRC Advance Notice of Intent to Pursue License Renewal," to inform addressees about the importance of providing the NRC with advance notice of their plans for license renewal. The RIS indicates that the Staff needs this information to better plan and budget for the processing of renewal applications. This letter is provided as advance notification that Dominion Nuclear Connecticut, Inc. (DNC) is considering license renewal for Millstone Unit Nos. 2 and 3. It is anticipated that the License Renewal Applications for Unit Nos. 2 and 3 would be submitted in the first quarter of 2004.
