An exemption was previously granted pursuant to 10 CFR 70.24. The exemption was granted with NRC materials license No. SNM-1916, issued March 4, 1985, and relieved the licensee from the requirement of having a criticality alarm system. Therefore, the licensee is exempted from the criticality alarm system provision of 10 CFR 70.24 so far as this section applies to the storage of fuel assemblies held under this license.

E. The licensee shall implement and maintain in effect all provisions of the approved fire protection prgraom as described in the licensee's Fire Protection Report and the licensee's letters dated September 23, 1986, October 23, 1986, November 3, 1986, December 12 and 15, 1986, and January 21, 1987, and as approved in the SER dated February 1982 through Supplement No. 8, subject to the following provision:

The licensee may make changes to the approved fire protection program without prior apporval of the Commission only if those changes would not adversely affect the ability to achieve and maintain safe shutdown in the event of a fire.
