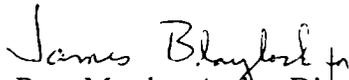

6. Description of Condition:

Contrary to the above requirements, it was discovered during OQA Supplier Audit OQA-SA-02-001 of Atomic Energy of Canada, Limited (AECL) Whiteshell Laboratory located in Pinawa, Manitoba, Canada, that electronically controlled copies of Yucca Mountain Project Procedures called out in contract DOE-AC08-00NV12137 for Busted Butte Radionuclide Transport Studies have not been available. Investigation during the audit revealed that from 2/12/01 through 10/03/01, updated controlled copies of implementing documents were not available to AECL personnel.

This allows for centralized control over the controlled source of information by BSC while providing the required access to the AECL and NRC. Access to the controlled source by the AECL and NRC will be provided through the RSIS authentication server that in turn will point to the controlled source. A BSC "Q" line procedure will be developed to ensure that updates to the controlled source are verified and that all information contained in the controlled source is up-to-date and accurate.

The fundamental problem that resulted in DR YMSCO(V)-02-005 was the lack of currency between the controlled data source and the replicated copy. The only way to effectively resolve this problem is to discontinue replication and re-direct users to the controlled source of information. The proposed solution to address the DR is to modify AP 6.1Q to specify the controlled sources (hardcopy and electronic). Access to the controlled source by external parties (ie. AECL, National Labs, NRC, etc) will be through the RSIS Proxy/Authentication server that will then proxy to the controlled source.

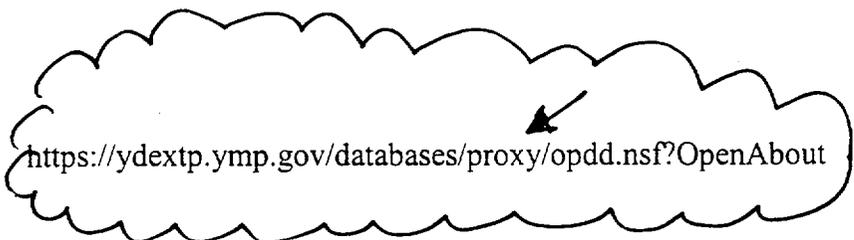

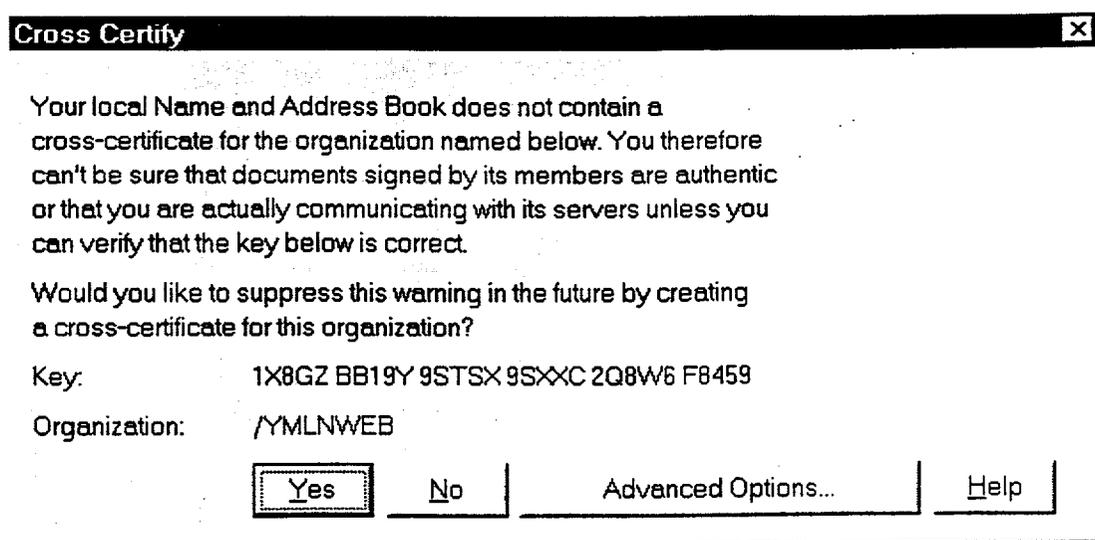
