RCIC WARM-UP VALVE MOTOR OPERATOR WOULD PROVIDE INSUFFICIENT THRUST TO CLOSE FOR A POSTULATED HELB OUTSIDE CONTAINMENT.

THE LICENSEE SUBMITTED THE FOLLOWING FAX:
"DURING HIGH ENERGY LINE BREAK (HELB) CALCULATION REVIEW, THE
ORIGINAL VENDOR DATA FOR "RCIC-V-76" WAS DETERMINED TO BE
INCORRECT. THE SIZE OF THE MOV ACTUATOR CURRENTLY INSTALLED ON
"RCIC-V-76" WAS BASED ON A VALVE PLUG SIZE WHICH WAS JUST
DISCOVERED TO BE ONE-THIRD OF ITS ACTUAL PLUG SIZE. FOR NORMAL
RCIC OPERATIONS THIS MOV HAS PROVED TO BE ADEQUATE. HOWEVER, FOR
A POSTULATED HELB DOWNSTREAM OF "RCIC-V-76" (AND OUTSIDE
CONTAINMENT), THE CURRENTLY INSTALLED MOV CANNOT PROVIDE
SUFFICIENT CLOSING THRUST IN ITS CURRENT CONFIGURATION (i.e. THE
MOV WILL NOT CLOSE "RCIC-V-76" AFTER HELB).

THE IMPACT OF THE INABILITY TO CLOSE "RCIC-V-76" DURING HELB OUTSIDE PRIMARY CONTAINMENT IS TO CHALLENGE THE ABILITY OF SECONDARY CONTAINMENT TO PERFORM ITS SAFETY FUNCTION AND ACCIDENT MITIGATION.

CURRENTLY, "RCIC-V-76" IS DE-ENERGIZED AND CLOSED IN RESPONSE TO THIS FINDING. RCIC IS NOT CONSIDERED INOPERABLE BECAUSE "RCIC-V-76" IS NOT REQUIRED TO BE OPEN IN ORDER FOR RCIC TO START OR RUN DURING ANY PLANT UPSET OR TRANSIENT."

THE VALVE PLUG SIZE REFERS TO THE SIZE OF THE PLUG THAT MOVES INTO THE VALVE SEAT. THE VALVE IS A ONE INCH RATED VALVE ON A ONE INCH LINE. THE VALVE IS USED FOR WARMING UP RCIC TO PUT IT INTO A STANDBY STATUS (LIKE FOR A STARTUP FROM COLD SHUTDOWN). THE LONG TERM CORRECTIVE ACTION IS BEING INVESTIGATED, AND MAY POSSIBLY INVOLVE RE-CONFIGURING OR REPLACING THE MOTOR OPERATOR. THE LICENSEE WILL NOTIFY THE RESIDENT INSPECTOR.
