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

AMENDMENT TO FACILITY OPERATING LICENSE

Amendment No. 114  
License No. DPR-29

1. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) has found that:
  - A. The application for amendment by Commonwealth Edison Company (the licensee) dated May 10, 1988, complies with the standards and requirements of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended (the Act) and the Commission's rules and regulations set forth in 10 CFR Chapter I;
  - B. The facility will operate in conformity with the application, the provisions of the Act, and the rules and regulations of the Commission;
  - C. There is reasonable assurance (i) that the activities authorized by this amendment can be conducted without endangering the health and safety of the public, and (ii) that such activities will be conducted in compliance with the Commission's regulations;
  - D. The issuance of this amendment will not be inimical to the common defense and security or to the health and safety of the public; and
  - E. The issuance of this amendment is in accordance with 10 CFR Part 51 of the Commission's regulations and all applicable requirements have been satisfied.
2. Accordingly, the license is amended by changes to the Technical Specifications and Environmental Protection Plan as indicated in the attachment to this license amendment, and paragraph 3.B. of Facility Operating License No. DPR-29 is hereby amended to read as follows:

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B. Technical Specifications

The Technical Specifications contained in Appendices A and B, as revised through Amendment No. 114, are hereby incorporated in the license. The licensee shall operate the facility in accordance with the Technical Specifications.

3. This license amendment is effective as of the date of its issuance.

1.0 INTRODUCTION

To improve clarity of the Quad Cities Nuclear Power Station (QCNPS), Unit 1, Technical Specifications (TS) and Environmental Protection Plan (Non-Radiological), Commonwealth Edison Company (CECo, the licensee) retyped Appendices A and B of Facility Operating License DPR-29 in their entirety and submitted them as an amendment by application dated May 10, 1988.

2.0 EVALUATION

The retyped version of TS (Appendix A) and Environmental Protection Plan (Appendix B) submitted by CECo for amendment to DPR-29 included the following changes: 1) improved grammar, 2) corrected typographical errors, 3) revised textual format, 4) consistent type fonts, 5) corrected spelling, 6) proper punctuation, and 7) re-designated page numbers. This total retype and editorial proofing was possible in part because of today's word processing capabilities. The intent of this entire revision of Appendices A and B is to improve legibility and clarity, and establish the framework for simplifying future amendments with word processing.

Since no technical content changes were made to Appendices A and B of DPR-29, the NRC staff has concluded this amendment is acceptable.

3.0 ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATION

The amendment relates to changes in recordkeeping, reporting, or administrative procedures or requirements. Accordingly, this amendment meets the eligibility criteria for categorical exclusion set forth in 10 CFR 51.22(c)(10). Pursuant to 10 CFR 51.22(b) no environmental impact statement nor environmental assessment need be prepared in connection with the issuance of this amendment.

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#### 4.0 CONCLUSION

The staff has concluded, based on the considerations discussed above, that: (1) there is reasonable assurance that the health and safety of the public will not be endangered by operation in the proposed manner, and (2) such activities will be conducted in compliance with the Commission's regulations and the issuance of this amendment will not be inimical to the common defense and security nor to the health and safety of the public.
