By letter dated October 28, 1976 Commonwealth Edison Company (CECo) proposed to amend the Technical Specifications to Facility Operating Licenses DPR-29 and DPR-30 in order to authorize operation with one automatic depressurization valve out of service for up to 30 days. By letter dated January 5, 1977 the NRC requested that CECo submit additional information related to your proposal so that we could continue our review.
