- Purpose: The Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) is re-issuing for comment a draft of NUREG-1556, Volume 9, "Consolidated Guidance About Materials Licenses; Program-Specific Guidance About Medical Use Licenses." This licensing guide is a companion to the recently published revision to 10 CFR Part 35, "Medical Use of Byproduct Material." The NRC is also holding public workshops to obtain stakeholder input on content of this guidance and NRC staff is especially interested in stakeholder comments that will improve the guidance to make it useful to applicants for medical use licenses, including licensees in Agreement States. The NRC is focusing on making the guidance risk-informed and performance-based. The emphasis in the workshop April 25th will be on guidance related to therapeutic applications of byproduct materials. The emphasis in the workshop on April 30th will be on guidance related to diagnostic applications of byproduct material. Both workshops will be preceded by open houses to present the opportunity for informal interactions between attendees, both NRC staff and members of the public. A third public meeting is planned for late May or early June to seek stakeholder input on inspection guidance for 10 CFR Part 35.
- Participants: The workshops will be conducted as roundtable discussions among invited participants representing the broad spectrum of interests that may be affected by the rule and guidance. The interests include the regulated community, patient's rights interests, the NRC and other Federal and State regulators. Although the focus of the discussion will be among the invited participants, the workshop is open to the public.
