The U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (Commission) issued Amendment No. 91 to Facility Operating License No. NPF-62 for the Clinton Power Station, Unit No. 1 on July 22, 1994. The amendment updated the version of the American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM) Standard utilized to periodically perform laboratory testing of charcoal adsorber samples from the 1979 version of ASTM D3803 to the 1989 version.

Due to concerns regarding compliance with the new standard, your staff previously requested that the amendment clearly state that implementation would occur within 90 days of the date of issuance. Unfortunately, our license amendment did not reflect this request. The second page of the license amendment has been revised accordingly and is enclosed for your use. We have not reissued the Technical Specifications or Safety Evaluation issued with the original amendment.
