NRC STAFF SUPPLEMENTAL WITNESS LIST

Pursuant to the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board's (Board) Fifth Prehearing Conference, conducted on April 9, 2002, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Staff hereby notifies the Board and the Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA) that it proposes to call the following additional individuals as witnesses. The Staff has not yet designated the order in which it intends to call these witnesses and identifies them below in alphabetical order.

1. Robert Beecken. During the April 9, 2002 telephone prehearing conference, TVA counsel Brent Marquand informed the Staff that he may have informed Beecken that Gary Fiser had been tape recording conversations and that he should be sensitive of that fact.
2. G. Donald Hickman. Hickman works in the TVA Office of Inspector General and stated in a declaration filed April 4, 2002 that he prepared and reviewed responses to Senator Sasser's letter inquiring about issues raised by Fiser, William Jocher, and D.R. Matthews.
3. Katherine Welch. Welch worked in the Labor Relations organization during the events relevant in this proceeding. Welch can testify to legal advice provided by counsel Brent Marquand related to whether the 1994 settlement agreement between Fiser and TVA guaranteed Fiser a position.

In addition to these witnesses, the Staff also proposes to remove the following witnesses from its proposed witness list dated March 29, 2002.

1. Brent Marquand. During the April 9, 2002 telephone prehearing conference, Marquand provided the Staff the information it sought from his testimony. Therefore, the Staff will not call him as a witness in this proceeding.
2. Edward Viglucci. The Staff has agreed to accept the testimony of G. Donald Hickman of the TVA OIG in place of testimony by Viglucci. Therefore, the Staff will not call him as a witness in this proceeding.
